Sec. 26-1. Generally.

(a) *Fees covered.* All fees payable to the city, by reason of this Code or state law, shall be governed by this chapter; except that if any Code chapter or state law provides for or requires the payment of a fee to the city,

and this chapter makes no reference thereto, then such other Code chapter or law shall govern.

(b) *Payment.* All fees shall be due and payable in full at the time specified in the applicable Code chapter or state law, and if no such time is provided, fees shall be due and payable upon demand of the clerk or other authorized city officer or agency.

Sec. 26-2. Commerce fees.

(a) *Cigarette vending licenses.* The fee for the issuance of a cigarette vending license shall be \$1.00 per month.

(b) *Taxicab or car rental business licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a taxicab or car rental business license shall be \$10.00 for the first licensed vehicle and \$5.00 for each additional vehicle licensed by one licensee.

(c) *Peddler's license.* The fee for issuance of peddler, solicitor or transient merchant license shall be \$25.00 for one period or event. Such period or event is not to exceed four consecutive calendar days or part thereof. The fee for issuance of such a license for a year or a part thereof shall be \$100.00. All licenses shall expire on December 31 of the year in which the same is issued.

Sec. 26-3. Beer fees.

(a) *Off-sale beer licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of an off-sale beer license shall be \$110.00.

(b) *On-sale beer licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of an on-sale beer license shall be \$110.00 (full year), \$65.00 (six months).

Sec. 26-4. Liquor fees.

(a) *General restaurant licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a general restaurant license shall be \$2,300.00.

(b) *Wine licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a wine license shall be \$330.00.

(c) *Club licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a club license shall be the maximum allowable per Minn. Stat. § 340A.408 based on membership.

(d) *Sunday restaurant licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a Sunday restaurant license shall be \$220.00.

(e) *Set-up licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a set-up license issued by the commissioner of public safety pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 340A.414 shall be \$150.00 to a private party and \$25.00 to a nonprofit organization.

Sec. 26-5. Dog and other animal fees.

(a) *Dog licenses.* The fee for the issuance of a dog license shall be \$10.00 for a male or spayed female dog, and \$20.00 for an unspayed female dog.

(b) *Dog impounding and boarding fees.* The fee for impounding a dog shall be \$10.00. The fee for boarding an impounded dog shall be \$5.00 per day or fraction of day.

(c) *Other animals impounding and boarding fees.* The fees for impounding and boarding any other animal shall be the same as the fees listed above for dogs; except that if the actual cost to the city is higher, the fees shall be the actual costs.

(d) *Kennel licenses.* The annual fee for the issuance of a kennel license shall be \$50.00.

Sec. 26-6. Subdivision fees.

(a) *Variance applications.* The fee for an application for a variance from any provision of chapter 62 shall be \$100.00.

(b) *Plat review.* The fee for plat review by the planning commission, prior to preliminary plat, shall be \$100.00 plus \$10.00 per lot.

(c) *Preliminary plat submittals.* The fee for submitting a preliminary plat to the planning commission shall be \$35.00.

(d) *Final plat submittals.* The fee for submitting a final plat to the planning commission shall be \$35.00.

Sec. 26-7. Zoning fees.

Zoning fees shall be as follows:

- (1) *Building permits.* The fee for application for a building permit shall be \$25.00 and after the fact building permit fees will be \$325.00. An additional \$10.00 shall be paid for building permits in the fire zone which are reviewed by the fire chief.
- (2) *Conditional use permits.* The fee for application for a conditional use permit shall be \$100.00.
- (3) *Variance applications.* The fee for application for a variance from any provision of chapter 82 shall be \$100.00.
- (4) *Sign permits.* The fee for an application for a billboard permit shall be \$100.00. The fee for an

application for other sign permits shall be \$25.00.
After the fact sign permits shall be \$75.00.

(5) *Conditional use and variance resolution fees.* The applicant shall also pay, at the time of application, the county recorder's or registrar of titles' fee for recording a certified copy of the conditional use or variance resolution.

(6) *Amendment or rezoning,* \$200.00.

(7) *Appeal,* \$100.00.

(8) *Building appearance committee review,* \$75.00.

Sec. 26-8. Miscellaneous fees.

(a) *Vacation applications.* The fee for an application for vacation of any street, alley or other public way shall be \$200.00.

(b) *Dance permits.* The fee for the issuance of a dance permit shall be:

(1) Single dance permit, \$5.00.

(2) Annual dance permit, \$75.00.

(c) *Parking violations.* Parking ticket fee for violations of section 70-27 shall be \$10.00.

(d) *Burning permits.* The fee for application for a burning permit shall be \$1.00.

Sec. 26-9. Additional charges for subdivision, zoning and miscellaneous fees.

When determined by the council that the actual cost for consideration of subdivision fees as set forth in section 26-6 or zoning fees as set forth in section 26-7 will exceed the fees established by those sections such costs shall be assessed to the applicant based on the council's determination of the actual costs to the city of the application. In determining the costs of an application, the following items shall be included:

- (1) The costs to the city of staff time including direct salary and fringe benefit costs.
- (2) The costs of any consultants hired or retained by the city in reviewing and advising the city as to matters contained in or affected by the application.
- (3) The costs of printing and distributing documents.
- (4) The costs of public hearings or public meetings, including the publication of notices for such meetings.
- (5) The cost to the city of attorney's fees and expenses in reviewing and advising the city as to matters contained in or affected by the application.
- (6) Such other costs to the city as the council may deem appropriate.
