WORKSESSION MINUTES
July 6, 2010

Mayor Hakes called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

The council met with their EDA Board Representatives to discuss the city's priorities for the EDA. The EDA has two assets: Cedar Grove Business Park and Superior National Golf Course. The Golf Course Committee is working on a business plan. The city would like to make sure that repayment the business park bonds are also considered as needing revenue by the EDA and the County Board. The EDA has not been given their full levy potential. The EDA's Budget should include the repayment for the business park bonds as well as golf course needs. The EDA Board should remain central for both projects.

Kennedy, Hakes, and Roth will attend the Golf Course Committee meeting on Friday at 10:00 a.m. at Cascade Lodge. Kennedy will attend the EDA Board meeting in Sivertson's absence on Tuesday. The Golf Course Committee will meet with Sobanja, Fenwick and Braidy on Thursday.

Motion by Kennedy, seconded by Lenz to ask the Joint Cook County/City of Grand Marais Economic Development Authority to include the Cedar Grove Business Park Annual Bond Payment in their budget and levy. Approved unanimously.

Motion by Costello, seconded by Hakes to adjourn the meeting. Approved unanimously.
