CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2017-09

A RESOLUTION DECLARING SUFFICIENCY OF PETITION AND SETTING A PUBLIC
HEARING ON A VACATION COMMENCED BY A PETITION OF A MAJORITY OF
ABUTTING LANDOWNERS

WHEREAS, a petition signed by the majority of property owners abutting a portion of 13th and 14th Avenue W was received by the City Clerk on the 17th day of March, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the petition requested that the City Council pursuant to Minnesota Statute §412.851 vacate a portion of 13th Avenue W and 14th Avenue W legally described as:

*That part of Prospect Avenue (now called Thirteenth Avenue W) lying northerly of the north right of way line of Duluth Street (now called Second Street);. AND,
That part of Florida Avenue (now called Fourteenth Avenue W) lying northerly of the north right of way line of Duluth Street (now called Second Street).*

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has reviewed and examined the signatures on said petition and determined that such signatures constitute a majority of the landowners abutting upon the street to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said petition is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND MARAIS, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

The Council will consider the vacation of such street and a public hearing shall be held on such proposed vacation on the 26th day of April, 2017, before the City Council in the City Hall located at 15 N Broadway at 6:30 p.m. and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby directed to give published, posted and mailed notice of such hearing as required by law.
