CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2018-17

A RESOLUTION DECLARING SUFFICIENCY OF PETITION AND SETTING A PUBLIC
HEARING ON A VACATION COMMENCED BY A PETITION OF A MAJORITY OF
ABUTTING LANDOWNERS

WHEREAS, a petition signed by the majority of property owners abutting a portion of 6th Street was received by the City Administrator on the 6th day of August, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the petition requested that the City Council pursuant to Minnesota Statute §412.851 vacate a portion 6th Street legally described as:

That part of 6th Street lying between the West Half of Blocks 7 and 10, Van Brunt Lightbody's Addition

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has reviewed and examined the signatures on said petition and determined that such signatures constitute a majority of the landowners abutting upon the street to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, a copy of said petition is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND MARAIS, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

The Council will consider the vacation of such street and a public hearing shall be held on such proposed vacation on the 10th day of October, 2018, before the City Council in the City Hall located at 15 N Broadway at 6:30 p.m. and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administrator is hereby directed to give published, posted and mailed notice of such hearing as required by law.
